Ettore Trulli is Associated Professor of "Environmental and Sanitary Engineering" .

He is graduated with honors in Hydraulic Engineering at the University of Bari in 1989.

After some considerable experience in study abroad among which at the Hydraulic Institute of Delft and at Agricultural University of Wageningen (the Netherlands), gets a three-year scholarship for participation in the PhD program in "Environmental and Sanitary engineering" at the Polytechnic of Milan.

In 1993 he obtained a PhD at the Ministry of higher education and research.

Then he had a two-year postdoctoral fellowship.

In 1995, he for the role of researcher at the University of Basilicata in "hydraulics and water constructions" joining at the Department of engineering and environmental physics. In that role he conducts also research in the laboratory of sanitary and environmental engineering.

From 2005 he attends as Associate Professor at the University of Study of Basilicata.

The main research topics are the technologies for municipal and industrial wastewater pollution control, wastewater treatment supply, treatment and disposal of sewage sludge, the energy recovery and the recovery of materials from waste, the assessment of the effects of anthropogenic origin.

He teaches undergraduate courses in Civil and Environmental Engineering at the School of Engineering of University of Basilicata.

He is author of numerous scientific and technical articles published in journals, books and Conference proceedings, of national and international interest.

He joined as chairman and speaker at national and international conference; also he contributed to the activity of several national and international scientific and technical associations.

He is reviewer of scientific journals of national and international interest.

He attended at several research programs funded by the Ministry of University and Scientific Research, the Ministry of Agriculture, the Regions of Apulia and Basilicata, beyond programmes funded by private companies.
