SCIENTIFIC CURRICULUM VITAE:

Giansalvatore Mecca is full professor of computer science and computer engineering at the Department of Mathematics, Computer Science and Economics of the University of Basilicata.

He graduated with honors in Computer Engineering from Università di Roma "La Sapienza" and received his PhD, also from "La Sapienza", under the supervision of Paolo Atzeni. He is with Università della Basilicata from 1995, first as a research associate and then as an associate professor. He also had visiting appointments at the University of Toronto and Università di Roma Tre.

His research interests include information extraction and data management techniques for XML and Web data. He has also worked on cooperative database systems, string databases, deductive databases, and object-oriented databases. He has co-authored over 80 scientific papers, published in prominent venues of the field, including Journal of the ACM, ACM Transactions on Internet Technology, IEEE Transactions on Data and Knowledge Engineering, Journal of Computer and System Sciences, Information Systems, and all of the main database conferences (ACM-SIGMOD, VLDB, IEEE-DE, EDBT, ACM-PODS, ICDT).

He was co-chair of the Program Committee of the fourth International Workshop on the "Web and Databases" (WebDB'2001), held in conjunction with SIGMOD/PODS 2001. He chaired the program committee of the 19th Italian Symposium on Advanced Database Systems. In addition, he was member of the program committees of many international conferences.
